Reports to the Camp Director for worship assignments and planning.



Minimum Qualifications

- · Experience in planning and leading worship
- · Desire to lead youth in worship in a camp setting
- · Ability to lead youth of varying ages
- A philosophy of worship that is appropriate for the camp setting
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance; willingness to ask for help when needed
- Ability to follow tasks through to completion
- Good character, integrity, and adaptability
- · Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control
- · Takes initiative and a commitment to excellence
- College student or graduate, at least 19 years of age

General Responsibilities

- Participate in day to day camp activities as responsibilities require
- Work with Camp Director and other camp staff to implement daily worship times
- Work with Assistant Director to set-up and tear-down each worship experience

Specific Responsibilities

- Responsible for coordinating all equipment needs, including set-up and tear down
- Create all needed PowerPoint slides, or other media presentation software (i.e. Pro Presenter)

- Train selected Camp Staff on PowerPoint or other media presentation software
- Oversee praise team recruitment, training and scheduling
- · Compile an order of worship for each devotional time
- · Program age appropriate worship experiences for each camp
- Work with the Camp Director to ensure worship is a continuation of camp themes and daily topics
- Follow camp rules and ACU guidelines

Compensation

- Worship Leaders will be compensated on an hourly basis for 35-40 hours/week
- · Housing will be provided during the camp season
