Clothing needs:

Campers participate in lots of activities. Many campers go through two changes of clothes daily, depending on their level of activity. Please review this list carefully so you're adequately prepared for a variety of clothing needs! If your camper has any doubts about an item's appropriateness, please encourage them to leave the item at home.

- Shorts (mid-thigh length please) for indoor/outdoor activities and regular wear
- At least one pair of long pants or jeans
- Shirts*
- Shoes, closed toe
- Socks
- Kadesh Campers: modest work clothes & closed toe shoes for service projects
- MPulse Campers: extra shorts, T-shirts and socks for our daily SOAR Program
- MPulse campers: swimsuit (optional)
- Learning to Lead Campers: swimsuit for daily swimming

*Every camper will receive a camp themed T-shirt at check-in. These shirts are to be worn on Monday

Dress Code:

Our camp facility, Abilene Christian University, has an expectation of modest attire for all staff, students and community. As a camp we honor that policy. Please read the details that apply to our camps:

- Dress should be modest. These items are not acceptable: halter tops, tank tops, bare midriffs, and revealing skirts and shorts.
- Clothing with inappropriate advertising, pictures, and/or sayings that are contrary to the mission and Christian standards of ACU is prohibited.
- Campers, staff, and volunteers may be asked to wear "covering clothing" if these dress code standards are not met.

Final decisions about appropriate apparel will be made by the Head Counselor and Camp Director.

Do Not Bring:

Please don't bring items that could distract from camp programming. Any inappropriate items will be subject to collection by Camp Staff to be secured until the end of camp.

We require campers to leave their electronics at home or with their parent/guardian or the youth/children's minister that brought them to camp. In the event that a camper decides to bring a electronic device, we ask that it be given to our staff for safe keeping during the week.
